6. Give some phrases from the song which demonstrated who was in control. How does this truth affect your life?
7. In verse 2 Israel sings of God being their salvation. What were the Israelites saved from?

8. How do you see your salvation similar to the Egyptian salvation? (Galatians 5:1) What impact does that have on your everyday life?

9. As the song comes to a close, it changes from remembering the past to looking forward to the future. List at least three things that Moses prophesied about the future.

10. Why do the Israelites view their future with such hope? Are you able to do the same?
